

3 Simple Steps To Visualizing The Capacity Of A Storage Room

1

Mark Off Two 5'x10' Areas As Templates

Measure two '5x10' areas directly connected to each other. Doing so will provide both a 5'x10' and a 10'x20' area. Use masking tape or painters tape to define the perimeters. These will serve as templates for judging the size unit you'll need.

2

Pack Up And Place Into The Taped Areas

Gather everything you want to put into storage including your furniture, boxes, equipment, tools and equipment. Move everything you plan on storing into the taped areas. Stack items as you plan to inside the storage unit taking a ceiling into consideration.

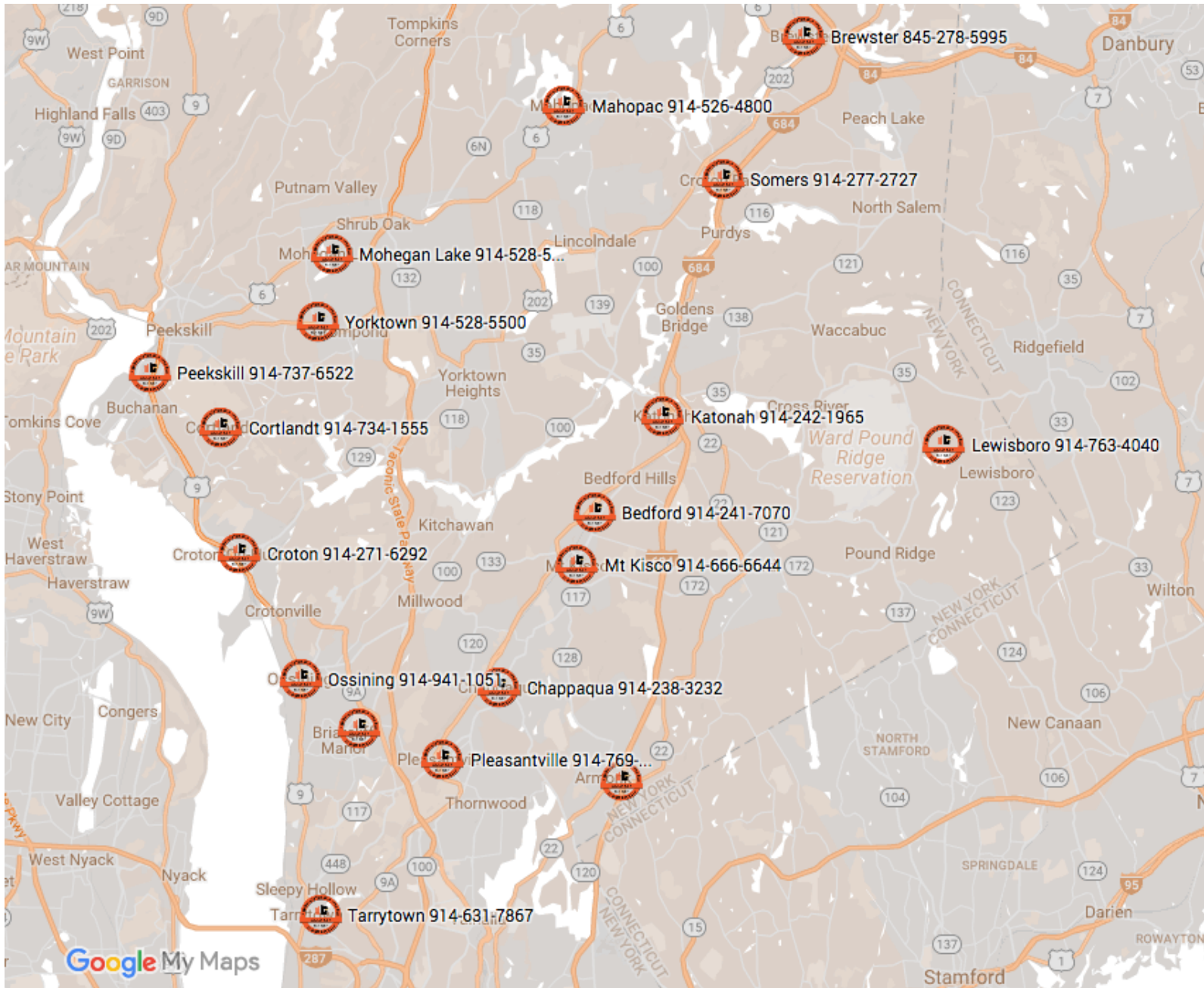
